RE: Design Update for the Alexander Street Design Project

This letter is to inform you of a project design update available online during early December 2023.

Improvements to Alexander Street are based on the 2017 Aloha Tomorrow Plan (ATP). During that process, County staff worked with the community to develop a starting point for a uniform road section for SW Alexander Street, between SW 178th and SW 192nd avenues. We propose to improve Alexander Street by:

- Adding curbs, separated bike lanes and sidewalks
- Installing parallel parking or landscape strips
- Improving storm water drainage and water quality facilities
- Updating signs, striping, streetlights and landscaping
- Building a pedestrian/bike crossing signal across SW 185th Avenue

These features would be contained within a future uniform 68-foot road section width (public right-of-way).

County staff has created a design update for Alexander Street, considering site survey, utility locations, site limitations and other information. This project limited to preliminary design only. Additional funding is needed for final design, right-of-way and/or easements and construction. We do not have a timeline for additional funding or work.

The design update is available for review and comment online between Dec. 1-17 Adjacent owners and nearby residents will have an opportunity to view additional project information and provide input on the design update through the below provided online link.
